Environmental Health Services

Consumer Services

Control & prevent food-borne illnesses:

- Conduct regulatory inspections
- Investigate complaints & foodborne outbreaks
- Educate food facility operators

Inspect & permit regulated facilities:

- Restaurants, Food Trucks & Festivals
- Day Care Centers, Schools, Nursing Homes & Hospital Dining facilities
- Swimming Pools & Spas
- Hotels, Motels & Bed & Breakfasts
- Massage Facilities



Prevention & control of:

- Rabies
- Insect-borne diseases
- Vermin



Onsite Sewage & Water Services

Protect public health & ground water quality:

- Evaluate & issue permits for well & septic systems
- Investigate sewage complaints
- Monitor sewage disposal systems for regulatory compliance
- License Drainfield Contractors & Sewage Handlers

Educate community partners on:

- Environmental health policies in Virginia
- Safety regulations
- Zoning and building requirements
- Chesapeake Bay protection requirements

Community Health Services

Clinical Services

The Health District offers services in two clinic locations - Manassas & Woodbridge.

Call these clinics to make an appointment & learn about patient eligibility or cost of services!

Immunizations

- Routine vaccines for infants, children & adults
- Seasonal flu vaccinations
- Vaccines for overseas travel



Testing & Screening for:

- Tuberculosis
- HIV & Sexually Transmitted Infections
- Pregnancy



Teen & Women's Wellness Clinics

- Routine exams & screenings, including testing for cervical cancer
- Family planning services & counseling
- Costs determined by sliding scale based on income



Prenatal & Postpartum Care

- Education & healthy behavior counseling
- Check-ups & routine care
- For women eligible by income



Other Services/Programs

- Long Term Care Screenings (for the elderly and/or disabled)
- Newcomer Health Assessment (for refugees)
- Every Woman's Life—breast & cervical cancer screening

Women, Infants & Children (WIC) Program

The WIC Program supports healthy eating for entire families by offering:

- Nutrition education
- Breastfeeding support
- Access to nutritious foods

Services are available to low-income pregnant, breastfeeding or postpartum Women, Infants & Children up to age five.
